IN OFFICE **HYSTEROSCOPY**








WHAT IS A HYSTEROSCOPY?

Office hysteroscopy is a way to evaluate the inside of the uterus before you pursue fertility treatment. The procedure involves passing an ultra-thin camera into the uterus through the vagina.



BENEFITS OF A HYSTEROSCOPY

The advantage of an in-office hysteroscopy is that it takes place in the office instead of the operating room. There is no need for general anesthesia, no incisions and your results are reviewed by your Doctor immediately following your procedure.

Office hysteroscopies allow your Doctor to fully evaluate the inside of the uterus and the opening of the fallopian tubes. Many times if something is found during a hysteroscopy (such as a polyp) it can be taken care of at the time of diagnosis.

Other procedures like a sonohysterogram (sono) or hysterosalpingogram (HSG) are only diagnostic. All in office hysteroscopies are performed in our Marlton office.



WHAT TO EXPECT AFTER YOUR PROCEDURE

After your hysteroscopy, you can expect some menstrual type cramping or spotting. You will be discharged with pain medication to take if needed. If you have any further questions or concerns after your procedure, please contact our office.
